By signing below, participants and their parents/guardians accept the potential challenges associated with the use of Zoom and other online platforms, including but not limited to: cyberbullying, privacy issues, oversharing of information (addresses, pictures of family, etc), and contact with new people.

French for the Future requests that families discuss potential challenges with their children and find strategies to ensure their safety and success while participating in the book club *Une page à la fois*.

Strategies may include:

- Communicating by text or email instead of on social media;
- Following age restrictions on websites (children under 13 shouldn't communicate through Facebook, for instance);
- Keeping social media profiles on private;
- Using applications where messages can't be deleted;
- Letting trusted adults know if anything causes participants to be uncomfortable.
